Statute on proof of practical experience or foreign language skills - 2019

Ruled by §39 para. 7 of the Universities Act (HSG) of 5 February 2016 (GVOBI. Schl.-H. p. 39), last amended by law of 10 February 2018 (GVOBI. Schl.-H. p.68), the following statute has been decreed by resolution of the senate of Kiel University on 5 June 2019:

§1 Proof of study qualification and responsible office

- (1) Apart from eligibility for university admission after the Universities Act and requirements for admission to Master studies defined in the examination regulations of the respective Master programmes, practical experience and foreign-language skills laid down in §3 are to be proven.
- (2) Proof has to be documented at the office responsible for crediting study and exam achievements.
- (3) The office responsible confirms that the required qualification has been documented. If practical experience or foreign-language skills have to be proven on enrolment, confirmation will be documented on a form provided by the student service office.

§2 Time of proof

Proof of the qualification listed under §3 has to be provided upon enrolment if not differently stated in §3.

§3 Required qualification

The following qualifications are required for the study programmes listed below:
